### **FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP TIPS!**



Two recent pieces of federal legislation may be of interest to Trinity's members and friends and are summarized below. **DISCLAIMER:** *The information shared in this document is for informational purposes only and is not intended to provide specific advice or recommendations for any individual.*

#### **Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) will start at age 72, not age 70½.**

Effective January 1, 2020, the SECURE Act may immediately affect your retirement planning. You will need to start withdrawing money from your traditional IRAs and employer tax deferred accounts such as 401(k)s, 403(b)s, and 457s at age 72, a change from the previous withdrawal requirement of age 70½. If you turned age 70½ in 2019 (born prior to July 1, 1949), you will still need to take your RMD for 2019 no later than April 1, 2020. If you are currently receiving RMDs (or should be) because you are over age 70½, you must continue taking these RMDs. Only those who will turn 70½ (born on or after July 1, 1949) in 2020 or later may wait until age 72 to begin taking required distributions.

#### **Required Minimum Distribution Waiver**

The CARES Act was passed by Congress and signed into law on March 27, 2020. Effective January 1, 2020, the CARES Act waives required minimum distributions ("RMDs") for defined contribution 401(a) plans, 403(b) plans, governmental 457(b) plans, and IRAs for calendar year 2020. The waiver applies to RMDs required to be made in 2020 and to 2019 RMDs that are required to be made by April 1, 2020 (if not already made in 2019). For purposes of determining RMDs after 2020, an individual's required beginning date is determined without regard to this 2020 waiver.

#### **Tax Benefits to Individuals**

Individuals are allowed to deduct up to \$300 of cash contributions "above the line", regardless of whether they itemize their deductions. The 50% of adjusted gross income limitation on charitable contributions is suspended for 2020.
