

The Family Life Center serves victims of abuse and provides safe shelter for women and children during times of extreme family turmoil and impending danger. ### MAY FINANCIAL UPDATE

#### **Financial Update**

<b>Cash Flow Perspective</b>	<b>May 2020</b>	<b>2020 Year-to-Date</b>
Total operating revenue received	\$28,748	\$157,891
Total operating expenses paid	\$28,117	\$143,700
<b>Operating Overage/Shortage</b>	<b>\$632</b>	<b>\$14,190</b>

- Revenue: Year-to-date through May 31, pledge receipts and contributions were \$13,000 better than budget. Thank you to all whose generous contributions made this possible!
- Expenses: Our personnel expenses were \$4,000 below (better than) budget, while operations expenses (includes Facility Care, Utilities, Office, and Insurance) were almost \$5,000 higher than the approved budget in spite of lower utility bills. In all areas combined, overall operating budget spending was \$280 above budget.
- Bottom line: Trinity needs \$29,000 monthly to cover expenses based on the approved budget 2020 budget. This does not include the underfunding of approximately \$15,000 for Facility Care and Office expenses nor does it cover the additional cost of weekly mailings. Trinity Presbyterian Church received a \$45,027 loan through the Paycheck Protection Program, which will support part of the payroll, lease payments, and utilities. Based on the latest legislation, Trinity will apply for loan forgiveness later this year.
