

SESSION BRIEFS

At its Stated Meetings on Zoom in April and May, and in person on June 15, 2020, your Session

- Noted the deaths of active members Catherine Leslie, John Pope, Doris Childress, Renee Schirrmeister, and Don Shelton.
- Accepted the retirement/resignation of Bob Tabit from Session.
- Noted that our online worship is well received.
- Noted that the Deacons have funds available for congregational assistance.
- Noted that Brooke and the youth are busy – Virtual Montreat was held in early June; VBS will take place June 22-26, two hours a day and only 20 kids; the Mission Trip for Middle Schoolers will be July 5 – 7 to Beth-el.
- Noted that shut-ins to whom Communion was taken each month are being contacted regularly.
- Noted that financially, Trinity is doing pretty well right now, due to reduced expenses as a result of current "shelter in place" practices as well as faithful contributions.
- Noted that a Stewardship Committee, chaired by Elder David Tiernan, will start meeting to make plans for a stewardship program this year.
- Discussed at length plans for re-opening the sanctuary for worship, and agreed to remain doing as we are doing now until our July 20, 2020 Stated Meeting. At that time there will be a discussion and a decision will be made about when to re-open.
- Noted that Trinity's participation in the Mayor's Food Initiative Program was very successful; we donated over 1700 pounds of food.
- Approved Resolutions of Thanks to Elder Bob Tabit for his many years of service on Session, to Sisters-in-Stitches for making the Covid-19 masks, to the Missions Committee for organizing Trinity's participation in the Mayor's Food Initiative Program; also to Jeff Cooke, Arvid Olson, and Megann Beebe for their work on the great on-line worship services.

The life, death, resurrection,
and promised coming of Jesus Christ

and the awful consequences
of the church's own complicity in injustice.
In the power of the risen Christ
and the hope of his coming,
the church sees the promise
of God's renewal of human life in society
and of God's victory over all wrong.
The church follows this pattern
in the form of its life
and in the method of its action.
So to live and serve
is to confess Christ as Lord.
