

MID-YEAR FINANCIAL REPORT JUNE 30, 2020

TRINITY ENDS 1ST HALF OF 2020 IN GOOD FINANCIAL STANDING


Through God's grace and with many thanks to all contributors, Trinity ended the first half of 2020 in good financial position! Year-to-Date operating revenue of \$175,802 was ahead of plan by \$2,025. Operating expenses of \$171,092 were under the planned amount by \$1,685. In-person services were suspended beginning on March 15th, and online worship continues for the foreseeable future. While members and friends continue to be very generous, the Finance Committee is concerned that the revenue received in the last 4 months is \$46,700 less than the same period last year. Trinity applied and received a Paycheck Protection Program loan in the amount of \$45,027 to help offset the decrease in giving due to the change in operations. These funds must be used to pay employees, utilities, and leases. Per the legislation, Trinity will apply for loan forgiveness later this year.

Many thanks to those who gave over and above their normal giving, which allowed Trinity

to use \$39,156 of restricted funds to support many events such as youth activities and Vacation Bible School. Missions' activities are not typically funded through the operating budget. Through June, Missions spent \$3,450 to cover such programs as the Family Life Center, Paws of War, Boys & Girls Club, and Whispering Meadows. Additionally, Missions also spent \$2,750 on the Family Food Program. Trinity also supported the One Great Hour of Sharing (\$985) and Souper Bowl of Caring (\$287). Historically, due to lower giving during the summer months, we begin to run a deficit until December, usually \$10,000 less than what is needed to cover fixed expenses each month. The bulk of the church's revenue comes from Pledged Giving (68%), which is used as the basis for our annual operating budget. You may be surprised to learn that approximately 48% of Trinity's members do not pledge. Each year's session-approved operating budget is based on faith that these non-

pledging members and members who gave above their pledged amounts will continue to do so at prior year levels.

All members and friends are encouraged to keep their pledges current. Trinity always welcomes new and increased pledges. Thank you very much for your generous support in the last six months during this historic time. Your continued contributions of prayer, time, talent, and treasure are greatly appreciated.




OPERATING BUDGET – Key Points

(Through June 30, 2020)

- **52% of members pledged in 2020**
- **Where YTD revenue came from:**
 - ✓ 68% came from those who pledged
 - ✓ 22% came from unpledged giving
 - ✓ 10% came from plate offerings & other revenue
- **Where Funds were Used:**
 - ✓ 68% of revenue was used to pay staff expenses
 - ✓ 22% of revenue was used to maintain the building, grounds, utilities, and insurance
 - ✓ 4% of revenue was used for Outreach (includes Communication, Membership, Stewardship, Presbyterian Commitments)
 - ✓ 5% of revenue was used for Office expense
 - ✓ 1% of revenue was used for Christian Education
 - ✓ <1% of revenue was used for Worship and Fellowship (Worship, Music, Congregational Life)
