11 He was praying in a certain place, and after he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." **2** He said to them, "When you pray, say:

Father, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come.

3 Give us each day our daily bread.

4 And forgive us our sins,

for we ourselves forgive everyone indebted to us.




We will observe social distancing and all are asked to wear a mask in consideration of others. We also ask that you bring your own chair.

JULY FINANCIAL UPDATE

God's Grace, Our Gratitude

Financial Update

- Revenue: July operating revenue was \$3,400 better than last month. Thank you to all whose generous contributions made this possible! Year-to-date revenue is \$5,600 less than budgeted through the first seven months, although the Finance Committee anticipates increased giving in the next five months based on historical patterns.
- Expenses: Our personnel expenses were nearly \$7,000 below (better than) budget, while certain operations expenses (includes Facility Care, Office, and Communications and Promotion) were almost \$10,000 higher than the anticipated budget through July. In all areas combined, overall operating budget spending through July was \$1,930 less than (better than) budgeted.
- Bottom line: Trinity needs \$29,000 monthly to cover operating expenses based on the approved 2020 budget. This does not include the underfunding of approximately \$15,000 for Facility Care and Office expenses nor does it cover the additional cost of weekly mailings. Trinity Presbyterian Church received a \$45,027 loan through the Paycheck Protection Program, which will support part of the payroll, lease payments, and utilities. Based on the latest legislation, Trinity will apply for loan forgiveness later this year. To everyone who has helped Trinity through time, talent, and treasure, we extend a big THANK YOU!
