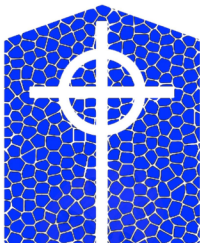

Old Testament Lesson (Unison) Psalm 1

<sup>1</sup> **Happy are those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or take the path that sinners tread, or sit in the seat of scoffers; but their delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law they meditate day and night.**  
<sup>3</sup> **They are like trees planted by streams of water, which yield their fruit in its season, and their leaves do not wither. In all that they do, they prosper.**  
<sup>4</sup> **The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away.**  
<sup>5</sup> **Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; for the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.**

New Testament Lesson 1 John 5:9-13

<sup>5</sup> **We accept human testimony, but God's testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son. <sup>10</sup>Whoever believes in the Son of God accepts this testimony. Whoever does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because they have not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. <sup>11</sup>And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. <sup>12</sup>Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. <sup>13</sup>I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.**

Affirmation of Faith (Apostle's Creed)

The Proverbs Scholarship Committee presents the graduating seniors for 2021. The presentation of our graduates to the congregation will occur on Sunday, May 16th.

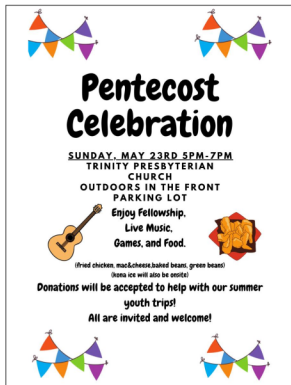
