Scripture Reading 1 Corinthians 12:1-11

12 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers and sisters, I do not want you to be uninformed. ²You know that when you were pagans, you were enticed and led astray to idols that could not speak. ³Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says "Let Jesus be cursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit.

⁴Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; ⁶and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. ⁷To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses.

New Testament Lesson John 2:1-11

2 On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. ²Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. ³When the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." ⁴And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come." ⁵His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." ⁶Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. ⁷Jesus said to them, "Fill the jars with water." And they filled them up to the brim. ⁸He said to them, "Now draw some out, and take it to the chief steward." So they took it. ⁹When the steward tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the steward called the bridegroom ¹⁰and said to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first,

and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now." ¹¹ Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.

Meditation "Water Into Wine" Rev. Jeff Beebe

* Affirmation of Faith (Apostle's Creed)

TRINITY BY THE NUMBERS

Happy New Year and welcome to an exciting adventure with Trinity Presbyterian Church in 2022. It is through your generous support and gifts that we are able to further God's work here in Palm Coast and beyond. Finance Committee wants to remind you to please include the Presbytery per capita fee and support of the stewardship envelopes in your contributions. This year your portion of the expense is about \$8.98 per capita per confirmed member and \$4 for printed envelopes for each giving unit. All congregations in the St. Augustine Presbytery, including Trinity, are assessed the yearly per capita fee on every member. The moneys collected are used to fund the Presbytery and General Assembly. Trinity will also contribute to the Presbytery Unified Mission Giving Fund, which the Presbytery uses for their mission to congregations. If you feel called to do so, you may also designate a gift to this fund.

If you contribute electronically, please choose per capita in the drop down menu. If you contribute by check, please make a note in the memo regarding the per capita contribution. Your envelopes are available for pick up in the Narthex for your convenience. If you need them to be mailed to you, please contact the church office to facilitate that request.
