Guiding Q: How do Jesus's words and actions in the Luke 13 passage expand your notions of how God loves us?

An Update on the PCUSA response to the Ukraine

“The present crisis in Ukraine demonstrates how important it is that our Church maintains strong relationships across the ecumenical, interfaith and humanitarian landscape *before* an emergency erupts,” **Presbyterian Disaster Assistance** Director, the Rev. Dr. Laurie Kraus says. “Through trusted partners in and beyond the Reformed Church family, we share across the region, we are able to demonstrate solidarity with refugees and displaced persons through immediate gifts to the communities leading relief work and receiving refugees.”

In addition to our prayers, we are invited to give in and through the **One Great Hour of Sharing** offering which enables PDA to response quickly to catastrophic events like what we are witnessing in the Ukraine.
