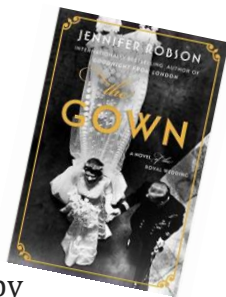

We typically see lower revenue in the summer due to travel, seasonal residents, etc., and we anticipate revenue increasing as we head into the Fall season.
