

God's Word to Us Hebrews 13:1-8, 15-16 (NT pages 213-214)

13 Let mutual love continue. <sup>2</sup> Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it. <sup>3</sup> Remember those who are in prison, as though you were in prison with them; those who are being tortured, as though you yourselves were being tortured. <sup>4</sup> Let marriage be held in honor by all, and let the marriage bed be kept undefiled, for God will judge fornicators and adulterers. <sup>5</sup> Keep your lives free from the love of money, and be content with what you have; for he has said, "I will never leave you or forsake you." <sup>6</sup> So we can say with confidence,

# **Trinity welcomes Rev. Dr. John White**

Rev. Dr. John E. White is a retired Presbyterian Minister. He was Ordained on October 11, 1981, in the Pittsburgh Presbytery and earned a Doctor of Ministry Degree from Pittsburgh Theological Seminary in 2009. Has also served at Princeton Theological Seminary and Columbia Theological Seminary as Vice President and Dean of Student Life as well as having served as Pastor of several congregations and in other service in the larger church.



Rev. White stated, "I have enjoyed the privilege of serving as the pastor of several congregations and as a senior administrator at three of our presbyterian-related theological seminaries. However, the highlight of my experiences in the PCUSA was when I met my wife, Alicia, when we were both serving as commissioners at the General Assembly that was held in Denver, CO in 2003. I retired from the work as the Dean of Student Life and VP of Student Relations at the end of December 2021.

Throughout this entire time in ministry, I have sought to be actively involved in both presbytery and in local congregations."
